

Assembly Instructions



Congratulations!

This fine piece of furniture will make a gorgeous addition to your home. For the best results, read the Assembly Instructions before you begin your project.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- For normal household use only. Not recommended for commercial use.
- Do not climb, sit or stand on this piece of furniture.
- · Do not overload the drawers or shelves.
- Unload items before you move this unit.
- Before you load or move this unit, tighten all screws and supports.



- Handle the glass plates with care. Glass is fragile.
- Before you begin your project, completely read the Assembly Instructions.
- Store this item: 1- in its box; 2- in a dry place; 3- in temperatures that range from 40°F to 90°F (not on a cold and possibly damp cement floor).
- Periodically inspect your furniture for any loose glue joints, screws or any other problem that might affect the stability of your furniture.
 Tighten or repair as needed.
- This assembly requires two people.




Assembly Instructions

Tool Required: Phillips Screwdriver, Pencil.

1. Place the unit at its final destination. Rotate the Adjustable Glides (ZC) on the bottoms of the legs until the unit is level. See Figure 1.




2. To insert your media components and access wires more easily, you may want to remove the Removable Backs (D). To do so, unlock the Turn Buttons (ZA) as shown in Figures 2 and 2b. Slide the Backs away and place them off to the side. After installing the components, slide the Backs (D) behind the Drawer Stops (X) and lock the Turn Buttons. See Figures 2, 2a, 2b, 2c.

3. To move the Adjustable Shelf (C), remove the #6 x 1/2" Undercut Screws (N) and the Shelves (C). Insert the Shelf Brackets (ZD) into the desired slots, place the shelves on top of the brackets and insert the screws. See Figures 3 and 3a.

4. Position the unit at the desired location. Locate one stud in the wall behind the unit. A strong small magnet is helpful to locate the studs in the wall. The magnet will help you find the nails or screws used to attach the wall to the studs. When you have found a screw you have found a stud. Studs are usually 16" on center. Choose the wooden stud which is closest to the center of your case. Attach a Clip (T1) to the wall stud with #8 x 2" Black Screws (T3). See Figure 4a. The clip attached to the furniture must penetrate solid wood such as a frame member behind the back, the top, an apron or a leg. Do not attach where it will be screwed only into the thin back panel. See the instruction for your individual furniture piece for recommended attachment point. Attach a second clip to the unit with #6 x 5/8" Philtruss Screw (T5). See Figure 4b. Connect the two clips with the Nylon Zip-Tie (T2). Pull the Nylon Zip-Tie (T2) tight so there is no slack. See Figures 4c and 4d. We have included an extra Nylon Zip-Tie in your kit; if you should need to move your furniture cut the Zip-Tie that you are using and replace with the extra Zip-Tie when the furniture is back in place.

The screws attaching your furniture to the wall must be inserted into a wall stud. Do not attempt to use wall anchors.
